RESOLUTION NO. 4-2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OSS SOLID WASTE DISTRICT FOR A COMPETITIVE FUNDING GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the OSS Solid Waste District offers competitive funding grants to be used to set up or expand recycling programs or, when recycling programs are established, to purchase materials made of recycled products; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Marblehead has an established program for recycling; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Marblehead desires financial assistance under the OSS Solid Waste District Competitive Funding Grant program to purchase products made from recycled material.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is authorized to file an application for a grant from the OSS Solid Waste District in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 which includes a local match of 25%.

Section 2. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.11.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Marblehead, and for the further reason that the filing deadline for grant applications is January 31, 2023 and therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
